

Wendo serves a variety of concrete purposes, including that of a Christian outdoor learning centre, a community development organization, an interactive arboretum, and an indigenous tree nursery,











As Wendo grew, so did our awareness of the needs around us. Locally, our commitment to promoting Environmental Stewardship opened doors into the community. This led to the formation of environment clubs in local schools, where children began learning the importance of caring for creation as an expression of faith and responsibility. These clubs became fertile ground for teaching sustainability, leadership, and a sense of belonging.



In the process, we recognized another urgent need—the struggle among children in our community with English literacy. This awareness gave birth to a new initiative: the establishment of the first library in our area. What began as a small collection of donated books soon turned into a vibrant learning space where children could read, dream, and grow.

To sustain and grow the library, we launched a unique exchange program: for every ten easy-reading books in good condition donated, one native tree sapling is planted. This creative model not only builds our book collection but also reinforces our core value of environmental stewardship. Churches and friends have embraced the vision, turning this effort into a beautiful cycle of knowledge and growth—where books plant trees, and trees grow hope.



As the vision of Wendo continued to expand, God opened our eyes to yet another area of need—children with physical and cognitive disabilities and their caregivers. In response, Wendo Youth & Family Camp Trust, in collaboration with professional counsellors, physiotherapists, and dedicated volunteers, began offering specialized programs to serve these precious children and their families.

Through our inclusive camps, children with disabilities are given the opportunity to experience joy, adventure, and belonging in a safe, loving environment. Alongside them, caregivers receive support through counselling services, moments of rest, and peer encouragement, creating space for healing and renewal. Every activity—from adaptive games to interactive group sessions—is designed to affirm dignity, celebrate potential, and reflect God's unconditional love.

These camps have become sacred spaces where families once burdened by isolation find community, and where children, regardless of ability, are embraced, valued, and empowered to thrive.

In addition to community outreach and inclusive programs, Wendo continues to invest deeply in the next generation through youth camps held throughout the year.

These camps go beyond the traditional; they are carefully crafted to integrate artistic development with mental health awareness, recognizing the unique challenges today's youth face.

Through music, visual arts, creative writing, drama, and other expressive platforms, young people are invited to discover their voice, process their emotions, and build confidence in a safe and nurturing environment. Alongside these creative sessions, intentional conversations around mental wellness are facilitated by professionals and trained mentors, helping participants grow in self-awareness, resilience, and emotional strength.

These camps not only awaken creativity but also provide youth with tools to navigate life with courage, faith, and purpose—strengthening their identity and grounding them in hope.
